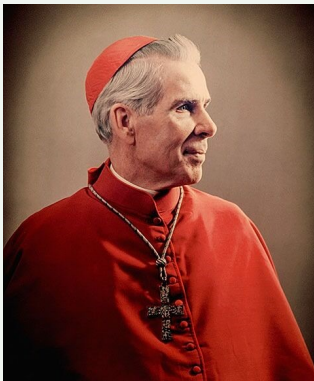

Bishop John Stowe's Statement on the death of Pope Benedict XVI

“We mourn the loss of a great man of the Church, the pope emeritus Benedict XVI. He emerged as a great theologian at the time of the Second Vatican Council and continued to reflect on the major questions of the day, especially the most important one of all about belief in God and belief in Jesus Christ, and how to communicate that belief today. His writings on the liturgy over the years were very influential, and his encyclical *Deus Caritas Est* will likely be regarded as his major contribution to papal magisterial teachings. Known as the uncompromising enforcer of orthodoxy from his years as Prefect of the Congregation of the Doctrine of the Faith under Saint John Paul II, he was also experienced as a gentle and kindly priest who loved classical music, playing the piano, and his cats. May he experience the reward of his labors.”
