 abortion, gun violence, school choice, and criminal justice reform.

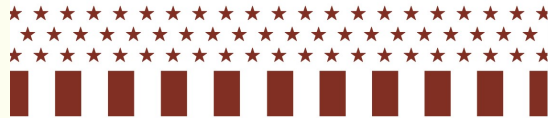

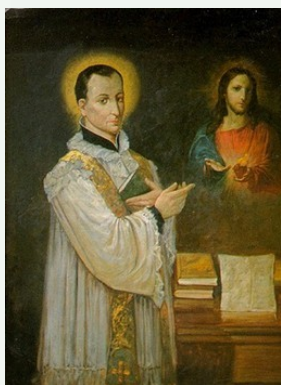


The Committee for the Sanctity of

Sterling, Morehead, Paris, and Richmond), will host a Synod Listening Session at St Mark in Richmond, with Bishop John Stowe in attendance, on **Sunday, February 27th, at 2 PM**. The Session will take place in the St. Mark School gym. All those from the Bluegrass East Deanery are welcome to attend. A description of what the synod is about is given below (taken from the Vatican News Service):

The theme of the upcoming 16th Synod of Bishops is: "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission". Synodality indicates walking together and listening to one another but above all to the Holy Spirit. To deepen this essential characteristic of the Church, the upcoming synod is unlike any previous one. It starts with, and involves all the faithful at local Churches across the world, promising to listen to all, especially to laypeople. That is why this Synod is a 2-year process, starting from October 10, 2021, to October 2023.

YEAR OF THE FAMILY- Words from Pope Francis

The work of all the Church is a mission, relating to all peoples:

"The work of handing on the faith to children, in the sense of facilitating its expression and growth, helps the whole family in its evangelizing mission. It naturally begins to spread the faith to all around them, even outside of the family circle. Children who grew up in missionary families often become missionaries themselves; growing up in warm and friendly families, they learn to relate to the world in this way, without giving up their faith or their convictions. We know that Jesus himself ate and drank with sinners (cf. Mk 2:16; Mt 11:19), conversed with a Samaritan woman (cf. Jn 4:7-26), received Nicodemus by night (cf. Jn 3:1-21), allowed his feet to be anointed by a prostitute (cf. Lk 7:36-50) and did not hesitate to lay his hands on those who were sick (cf. Mk 1:40-45; 7:33). The same was true of his apostles, who did not look down on others, or cluster together in small and elite groups, cut off from the life of their people. Although the authorities harassed them, they nonetheless enjoyed the favour "of all the people" (Acts 2:47; cf. 4:21, 33; 5:13) (The Joy of Love, # 289)
